According to the mountain terrain, the different spaces of vacation homes are decomposed into "boxes" of varying sizes and themes, flexibly placed in ancient forests, surrounding the water scenery and extending towards the surrounding mountains until reaching the viewing platform at the top of the mountain. There are single family rooms that blend into the waterfront, treehouse rooms that blend into tree gaps, courtyard mansions that blend into mountain ridges, and row villas that blend into slope forests. Their architectural forms are undulating, echoing the mountain terrain.



This project uses an undersea immersed tube tunnel as the main connection line between the two continents, and an additional community bridge between the two Diomedede Islands. Several lighthouses are aligned above the tunnel connection, lighting the new connection of peace. They act together as the Bering tunnel ventilation system, also providing small observation and viewing platforms on top of the towers. The lighthouses can be seen as a comment to the world peace, where only the collaboration of all actors forms a visible connection.




MOUNTAINTOP SNUG RESORT HOUSE

The resort consists of two interconnected yet independent building blocks which are 200sqm and 100sqm respectively accommodating 6 to 8 guests. The design of the house adapts to the terrain's constraints, with the two structures descending from west to east. The first cantilevered structure sits towards the uppermost part of the site. The second structure is nestled beside the lower rock, seamlessly integrating the natural scenery. Sunlight from the north penetrates the interior of the structures and reflects beautifully off the surrounding rocks.

SEAFORTH HOUSE IN SYDNEY

The main facade of SEAFORTH HOUSE faces south, maximizing the introduction of the harbor scenery into the interior. At the same time, in order to better utilize natural light from the north, the north-south depth of the building is only 7 meters, and ground glass windows are used on the facade. Adjustable blinds are installed on the outside, and the rich space brought by overhanging, overhead, etc. breaks through the traditional separation and blurs the indoor and outdoor boundaries. The living area is at the same level as the street level, while the bedroom is located at a lower level along the terrain slope, adjacent to the terrain. The natural area is divided into an activity area and a private living area, with excellent privacy. Ensure that all hotel rooms have a good viewing effect, with the landscape, courtyards, and buildings arranged in a staggered manner, and the building facades blending with the scenery.
