Newspapers and printing are the two most representative elements in the newspaper industry culture. The overall concept aims to incorporate the characteristics of Guangzhou's Lingnan culture, particularly its water culture, which represents the city's unique features, along with elements closely related to the newspaper industry. The goal is to create a comprehensive architectural complex that is lively, has distinct connotations, and showcases regional cultural characteristics.

In terms of architecture, the design utilizes cantilevered floor slabs and externally-mounted metal sunshades to emphasize the horizontal lines of the entire building, enhancing the sense of floating paper. The ground level utilizes variations in height to create a diverse open space for outdoor terraces. This allows the concept of paper to be fully functional in both the architecture and the landscape, giving it a significant presence.

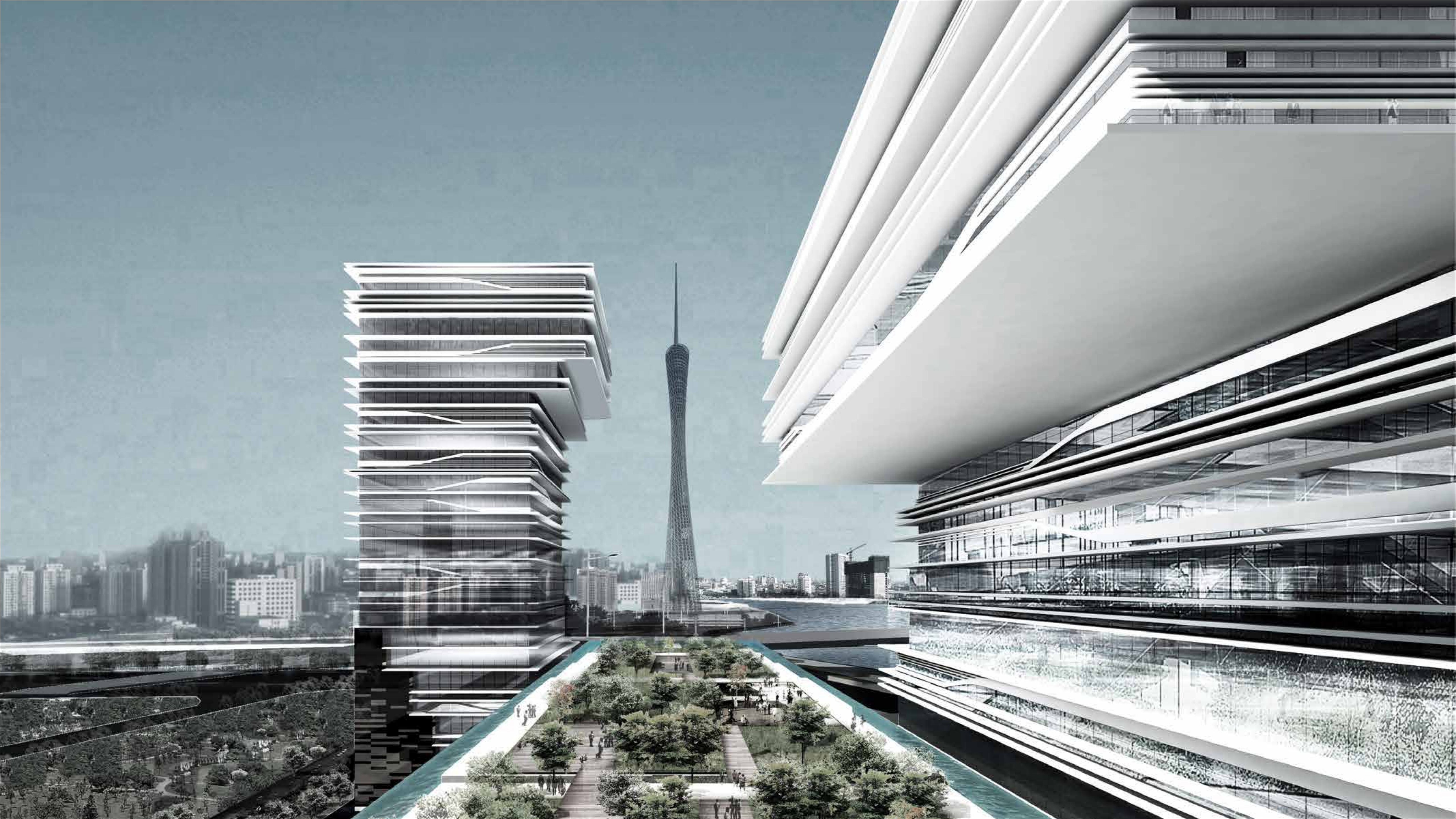

The library is located in the central-northern part of Heyuan Hakka Cultural Park, benefiting from exceptional land and landscape conditions. The three common types of Hakka architecture found in the area are "Tulou," "Weilongwu," and "Wufenglou." Among them, "Wufenglou" is the most prevalent and widely distributed in Hakka settlements, holding a significant position as the origin of Hakka architecture. Its layout and spatial composition reflect reverence for ritual and ethics while carrying rich symbolic meanings. Therefore, it serves as the primary inspiration for our design concept. The proposed design combines the architectural forms of square Tulou and "Weilongwu." The five functional buildings are arranged in response to the sloping terrain, harmonizing with traditional architectural layouts and providing a panoramic view of the beautiful lake scenery.

In our vision, the OCAT Xi'an Pavilion is not only a building that carries the historical and cultural significance of the "Zhou" dynasty but also a showcase of contemporary art and culture. The overall architectural layout is square-shaped, featuring a sleek and modern facade. Drawing inspiration from the architecture of the Zhou dynasty, the building conceptually represents a historical monument situated on a grassy slope, symbolizing a reflection on the "Zhou" historical and cultural heritage.

Extracting key elements from the historical events and timeline of the Pearl Beer Factory, the spatial re-creation aims to evoke the special memories of the factory buildings for the public. Simultaneously, focusing on the theme of beer brewing, it creates a concept of immersive museum exploration. By utilizing the existing preserved industrial buildings, the brewing process is integrated to reshape and redefine their functions, resulting in themed commercial spaces related to brewing culture. The immersive experience follows a backward journey from the final product of beer to the original barley fields.

The building facades feature rhythmic light-colored forms, distinguishing them from the modern glass curtain walls of the surrounding high-rises, presenting a more approachable demeanor. The consolidation of architectural volumes and the simplified rationality in form treatment are considerations

The Pavilion And Park Project is located on the north side of Haizhu Lake Wetland Park in Guangzhou, adjacent to a vast orchard in the east, boasting a favorable ecological environment. It serves as a crucial node in the southern section of Guangzhou's new urban axis, comprising the Guangzhou Cultural Center and the Lingnan Garden. By incorporating large-scale public buildings into Haizhu Lake Park, our approach is not to showcase grand architectural volumes but to modestly integrate the new buildings into the park's ecological landscape. The design of the public cultural center fully embraces Guangzhou's climatic characteristics, daringly incorporating Lingnan green plants as part of the facade design, creating a symbiotic relationship between the building and the greenery, establishing a new expression of Lingnan architecture.

THE INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION HONORABLE MENTION

The design concept is based on the idea of "elevated platforms and thick pavilions." By utilizing suspended architectural volumes, the landscape permeates into the urban area from the Feng River, simultaneously releasing the ground floor space. The rooftops are transformed into elevated parks, establishing connections and extending the landscape to the surrounding plots. This creates a vibrant waterfront environment along the Feng River, linking the Feng River Green Belt and the east-west landscape corridors. The three major functional building nodes and landscape nodes form the spatial axis of the plot. The Civic Center comprises a Sports Center, Cultural Center, and Technology Center. These three functions are connected through elevated corridors, allowing for horizontal functional integration and increasing the possibilities for building use. The ground floor space of the entire complex is fully open, vertically linked with each functional area, shaping a 24-hour open and dynamic public community. The rooftop design allows for seamless
